Major Duties/Responsibilities

- Supports the staff of the Machine Assembly and Tooling Section in the development and implementation of strategies and procedures required to assemble and install of ITER systems;
- With input from the technical staff, assists in the preparation of assembly procedures (machine assembly procedures, survey procedures, Quality Assurance procedures, etc.);
 - Assists in the preparation of technical documentation, including technical specifications, interface control documentation, internal technical reports;
- Handles the technical organization of design reviews and other official meetings, prepares agendas, drafts minutes and action lists;
 - Develops and maintains the computer and web based filing systems for the Section;
 - Participates in the selection, development and implementation of software applications required to support the development and execution of the assembly procedures;
 - Maintains a strong commitment to the implementation and perpetuation of the ITER Safety Program, values and ethics.

Qualifications and Experience

- Education:
 - Technical degree or diploma equivalent to at least 2-4 years of study after the High School Diploma, in mechanical engineering, technical administration or other relevant discipline.
- Technical experience:
 - Minimum of 5 years' experience in a similar position in a large multi-disciplinary project performed in an international environment.
- Social skills:
 - Ability to work effectively in a multi-cultural environment;
 - Ability to work in a team and to promote team work.
- Language requirements:
 - Excellent command of the English language (written and spoken).



- Computer and IT skills:
 - Computer literate and proficient in the use of the Microsoft Office software suite (Word, Excel, Powerpoint, etc);
 - Experience in the use of procedure development and tracking, and/or database management software.
