<b>Main duties / Responsibilities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Organizes the security of the ITER Joint Work Site (JWS) premises on current perimeter and later for the buildings of the definitive ITER site.</li> <li>• Organizes the security of the ITER facilities in all phases of design, construction, operation, end of operation and deconstruction.</li> <li>• Implements security measures foreseen in the Headquarters Agreement between the ITER Organization and the French Government.</li> <li>• Makes regular surveys about the application of French, European, IAEA and other international regulations for security issues in all phases of the ITER project.</li> <li>• Establishes and maintains relationships with the French authorities and Domestic Agencies concerning security activities.</li> <li>• Ensures the representative interface between the Director of Department for Safety, Quality and Security and the host services that will be agreed concerning plant security.</li> <li>• Ensures the representative interfaces between the Director of Department for Safety and Security with other ITER Departments and Office referring to security activities.</li> <li>• Ensures the representative interfaces between the DDG for Safety, Quality and Security with host authorities referring to security activities.</li> <li>• French high level security clearance will be required.</li> <li>• Maintains a strong commitment to the implementation and perpetuation of the ITER Safety Program, values and ethics.</li> </ul>
<b>Measures of effectiveness</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Successfully supports the ITER Organization to implement security measures and develop security control systems.</li> <li>• Successfully ensures IO security records are complete and conform to the IO and French rules and regulations.</li> </ul>
