Purpose	<p>To support the Configuration Management Section / Division (CMD) Head in the management of the ITER requirements and control of requirements traceability, verification and validation.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Supports the development and improvement of the requirement management processes and implements procedures to ensure that the top level safety and technical objectives are correctly identified, allocated to and verified for the lower level project elements (systems, structures and components), then validated, as well as tracked;• Supports the improvement of the requirement data model as part of the control of requirements traceability, verification and validation;• Support the development of the requirements database with incorporation of the new functionalities required for the continuous improvement of process integration and control;• Administrates the requirement database (DOORS) (and a future successive database tool) & controls the access rights;• Develops and maintains How-to, templates and guidelines for the database;
Main duties / Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Produces regular reports on the status of the requirement propagation and compliance;• Controls and archives all records related to the requirement management process;• Supports the technical Responsible Officer (RO), system engineers and safety RO in the identification and control of the requirements propagation (e.g. creation of Propagation and Compliance Matrices);• Interacts with Domestic Agency (DA) staff to ensure continuity and consistency in the propagation of the requirements to DA activities;• Drafts common processes between ITER Organization (IO) and DA;• Supports the review of quality and compliance with the procedure of documentation produced in the requirement management process;• Contributes to the preparation of Training Materials and Training Sessions on Engineering Procedures for ITER and carries out training courses for potential users;• Performs other duties in support of the project schedule as described in the Detailed Work Schedule and the Strategic Management Plan;• May be requested to be part of any of the project teams dealing with the above activities and to perform other duties upon management request;• Maintains a strong commitment to the implementation and perpetuation of the ITER Safety Program, values and ethics.
